DeBock Elected Library Board Chair

North Vancouver – Matt DeBock was elected Board Chair and Ken Lim was elected Vice-Chair at the inaugural meeting of the 2015 North Vancouver District Public Library Board, held Thursday, January 22.

DeBock is an in-house lawyer for Hootsuite, a Vancouver-based company that provides solutions for social media management. Lim is a communications consultant, with a broad range of creative experience as a graphic designer, photographer and business owner.

The North Vancouver District Public Library Board includes eight volunteers and one elected Councillor appointed by District Council, under the terms of the British Columbia Library Act. The Board sets strategic priorities, develops policies and develops a library budget for District Council.

The 2015 Library Board includes five returning trustees and four newly appointed trustees. Along with DeBock and Lim, Lucy Cayuela, Sanford Osler and Frank Sullivan are returning. Mark Jefferson, Linda Munro, David Porter, and council representative Jim Hanson are joining the board. The Director of Library Services is Jacqueline van Dyk.

“I look forward working together with North Vancouver District Public Library trustees and staff to ensure our community continues to be well served by its library,” says newly elected Library Board Chair Matt DeBock.
