Serving almost 90,000 residents across three current locations in the District of North Vancouver, NVDPL has supported a love of reading and culture of learning and discovery for 55 years. While nurturing innovation and honouring tradition, our library is a place where our all members of growing community can learn more, create more, and connect more.

The North Vancouver District Public Library is looking for two enthusiastic and outgoing student assistants to help us with our Summer Reading Club. Every year the Library participates in this self-directed reading program, which encourages children of all ages to read for 50 days in the summer. Assistants will register children for the program, interact with them during return visits, create welcoming spaces, and gather and evaluate statistics.

We are looking for:

- post-secondary students who enjoy working with children of all ages
- young adults who are enthusiastic about reading & can model reading as an enjoyable activity
- team players who can share and implement creative ideas
- university/college students who are familiar with children's literature and are looking to gain more knowledge (ideally enrolled in a Library School, faculty of Education or Library Technician diploma program)
- welcoming & approachable personalities who can impart the same information with the same level of passion and enthusiasm

Funding for these positions is made possible by Young Canada Works, and as such candidates must meet the following criteria:

- Be between the age of 17 and 30 years of age and be legally entitled to work in Canada (have a valid SIN, be a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act)
- Be a student and intend on returning to full-time studies in the semester following the YCW job.

If you have a passion for connecting community, sharing knowledge, and inspiring stories, and you are interested in joining our dynamic team, then we'd like to hear from you!

The hourly pay rate for this unionized position is \$20.84 (2019 rate). This work requires flexible availability, including evenings and weekend shifts. The term of this position is for approximately 10 weeks, commencing early June and concluding at the end of August. There will be flexibility with returning to the school term.
